# ARKANSAS TOBACCO PREVENTION HIGHLIGHTS

Over \$24 million at work in Arkansas.

## ☑ COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

45 grantees are building coalitions and implementing tobacco control activities.

## ☑ SCHOOL PROGRAMS

18 Educational Cooperatives and/or school consortium grantees are focusing on tobacco prevention. The health department is partnering with Arkansans for Drug Free Youth to organize statewide youth programs called SWAT (Students Working Against Tobacco).

## ☑ ENFORCEMENT & SURVEILLANCE

The Arkansas Tobacco Control Board enforces state laws prohibiting the sale of tobacco products to minors & has established a toll free number (1-800-ID-TEENS) to report violations.

## ☑ COUNTER-MARKETING

Stamp Out Smoking (SOS) addresses the health effects of smoking and secondhand smoke through television, radio & print media.

## ☑ CESSATION PROGRAMS

The Arkansas Foundation for Medical Care is developing & coordinating a statewide network to deliver smoking cessation services. Arkansans can also call 1-866-NOW-QUIT to reach the SOS quitline.

## ☑ MINORITY INITIATIVES

The League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) is assessing smoking rates among the Hispanic population, implementing a statewide Hispanic Health Radio network & establishing a toll-free number for Hispanics to get health information & assistance. Arkansas Medical, Dental & Pharmaceutical Association (AMDPA) is providing prevention & cessation services for African American adults & youth.

## ECONOMIC BURDEN OF TOBACCO IN ARKANSAS

Arkansas spends approximately \$633 million in smoking attributable health care costs annually. (Campaign for Tobacco Free Kids, December 2002)

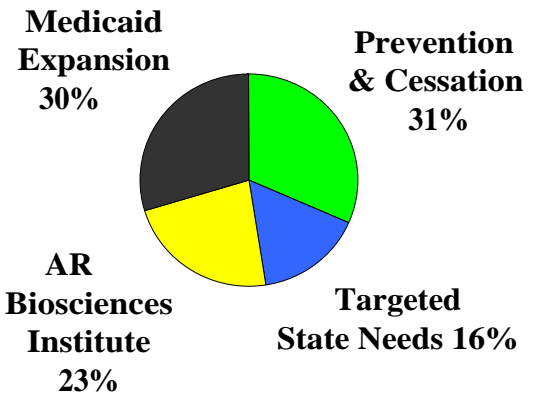
At present funding, for every \$14 million spent on Arkansas' tobacco control program, \$42 million is saved in direct medical costs. For every \$1 invested, \$3 is saved. (American Legacy Foundation, American Cancer Society, American Heart Association, American Lung Association, Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids, and the Smokeless States Initiative, Saving Lives, Saving Money: Why States Should Invest in a Tobacco Free Future, March 2002)

Each year the tobacco industry spends \$90.8 million to market its product in Arkansas. (Campaign for Tobacco Free Kids, December 2002)

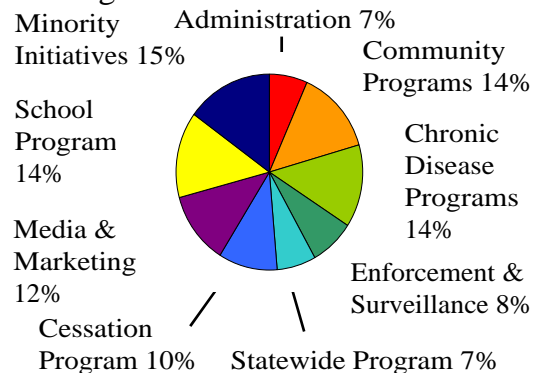
# DISTRIBUTION OF MASTER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT FUNDS

In November 2000, Arkansas voters passed Initiated Act One, commonly referred to as the CHART plan. This plan determined how our state's tobacco settlement agreement dollars would be spent. This funding was allocated in the 2001 legislative session.



*This is tobacco settlement fund activity from January 2001-June 2002. Funds from "Targeted State Needs" are divided between the College of Public Health, Delta Area Health Education Center, Donald W. Reynolds Center on Aging and Minority Health Initiative.*

The Centers for Disease Control & Prevention ranks Arkansas 5th highest in the appropriate spending of tobacco prevention funds. The CDC recommends states establish tobacco control programs that are comprehensive, sustainable and accountable. There are nine "best practices" designed by the CDC and followed by Arkansas. The nine "best practices" and distribution of tobacco prevention funds (rounded to the nearest whole number) during FY 02-03 are as follows:

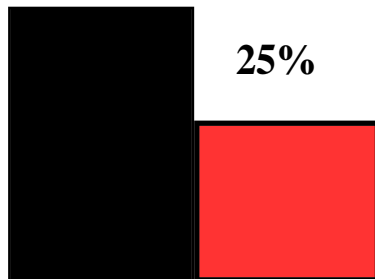

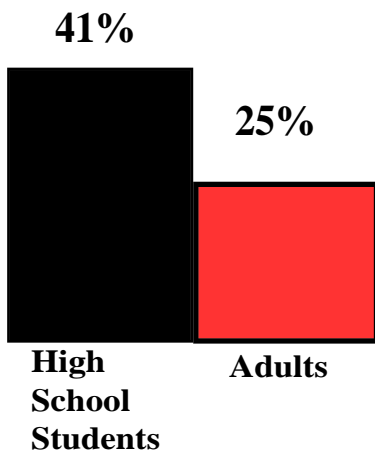

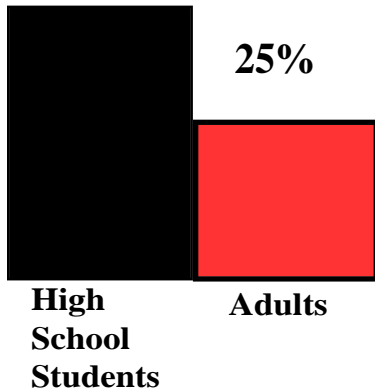

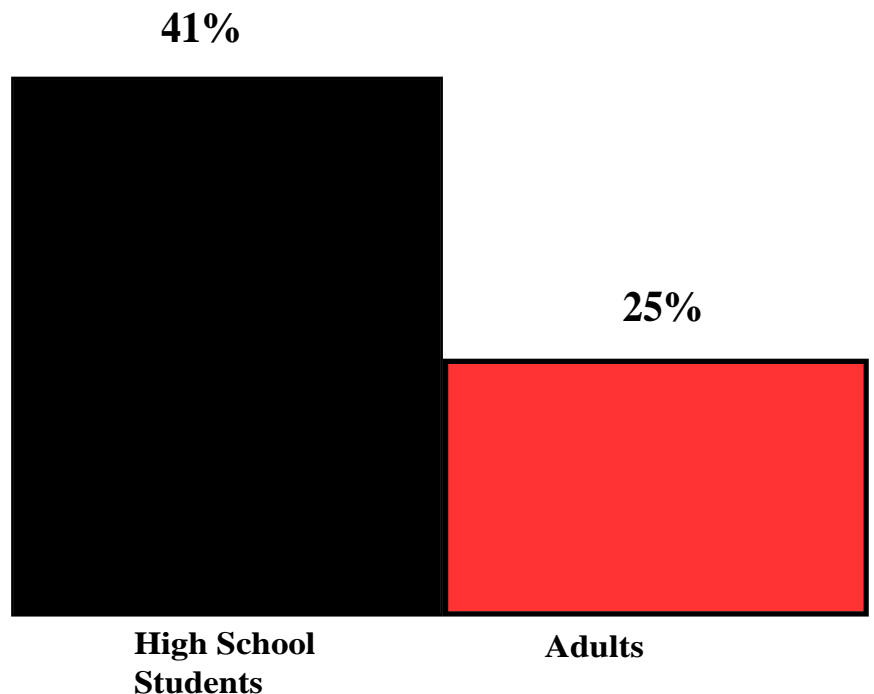

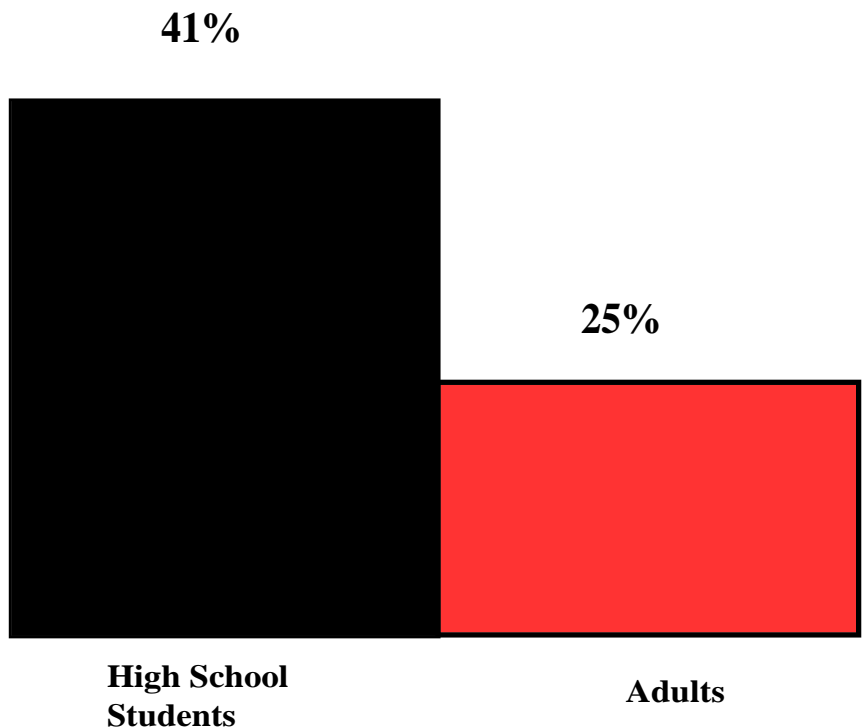

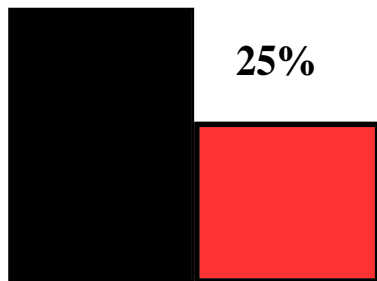

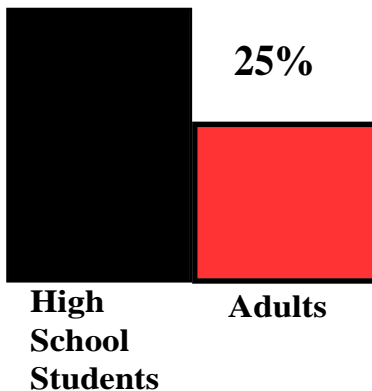

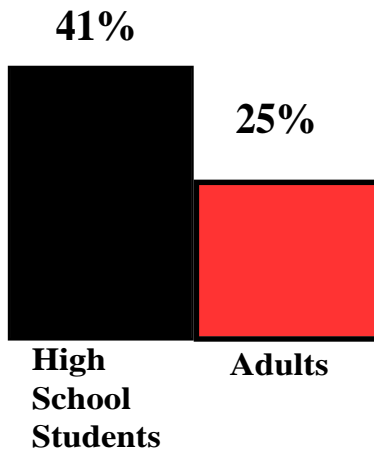

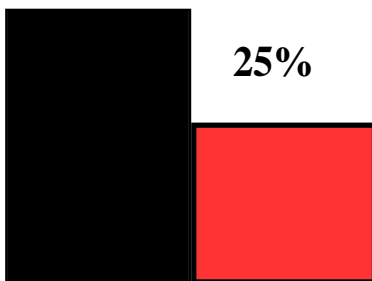

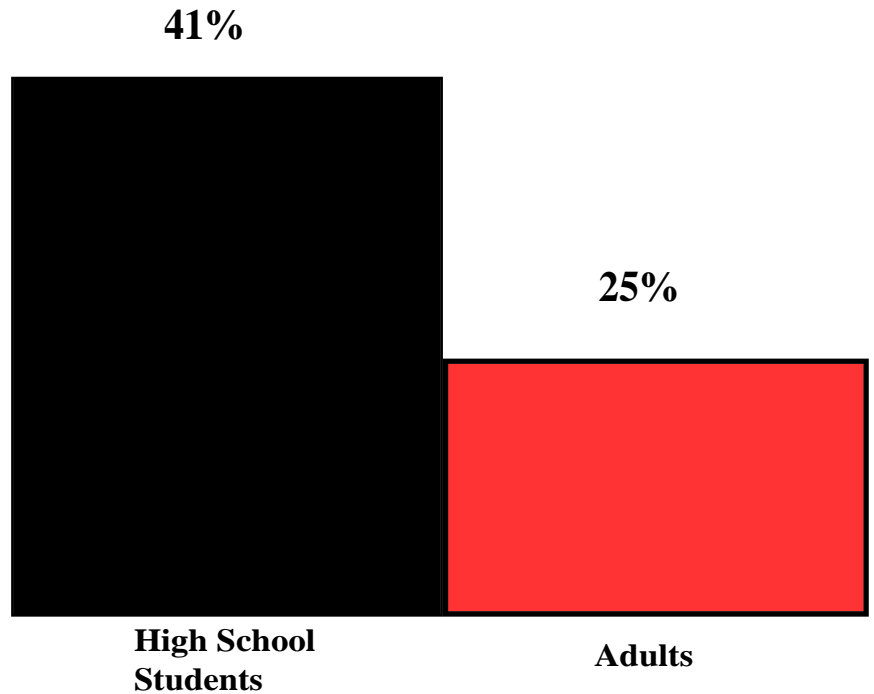
